THE INN



Mount Vernon Farm spans 840 acres of rolling hills, filled with warm and cool-season grasses, orchards, forests, and meadows teeming with wildlife. The inn is perched atop one hill where the Blue Ridge Mountains fill the skyline as far as the eye can see.

The inn and farm have been passed down through eight generations of the Miller family. In 1827, John Miller Sr. purchased the land from Francis Thornton and built a modest family home with his son, "Poplar John." The simple rectangular structure was built from bricks fired on the bank of the Thornton River and trees harvested from nearby Turkey Mountain.

The early Millers were successful dairy farmers and apple growers. By the early 1900s, the herd of dairy cows had grown large enough to justify the construction of the dairy barn. At 235 feet long, John Clifford Sr.'s barn is a marvel of engineering and one of the largest wooden barns of its era still standing in America today.

In 2010, Cliffs III and IV teamed up to renovate the family home and dairy barn to host guests and events. They welcome guests with a little bit of luxury and a lot of southern hospitality.

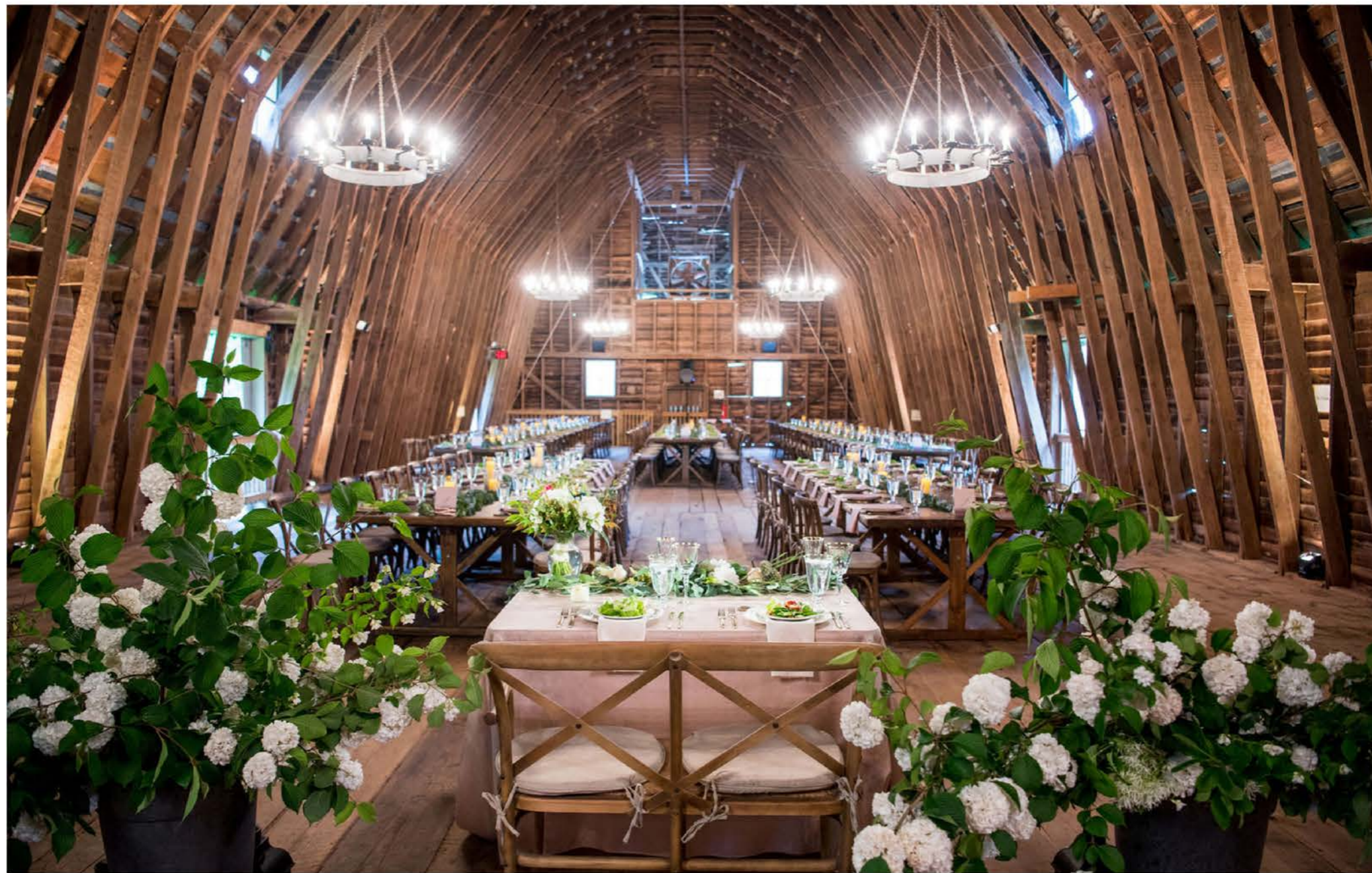

FAQS

What do your packages include?

Packages 1 and 2 include accommodations for two nights for up to 16 guests. Package 1 includes indoor or outdoor ceremony options and a barn reception. Package 2 does not include the barn rental. **Tents, tables, chairs, linens, china, or flat ware are not included in packages 1 or 2.**

When does our reception have to end?

Our event curfew (as dictated by the local noise ordinance) is 11 PM.

What does the event coordinator do?

Our event coordinator will:

- be your point of contact leading up to and on your event weekend
- meet vendors to accept and direct deliveries
- be on site in the case of an emergency or special need

What are your inclement weather options?

Package 1 includes the use of the lower level of our dairy barn for your ceremony in the case of inclement weather. You may also rent a tent from a vendor for your ceremony.

What is your cancellation policy?

If you must cancel your event, your cancellation notice must be delivered in writing, no less than 180 days prior to your scheduled event date.

Is event insurance required?

Yes, all couples must purchase event insurance with a minimum amount of coverage at \$1M with The Inn at Mount Vernon Farm listed as an additional insured party. You must provide us with a certificate of insurance 90 days prior to your event. This insurance is separate from and in addition to insurance provided by the licensed caterer.

Is there a security deposit?

There is a \$500 security deposit due one month prior to your event. Assuming all conditions are met, this deposit will be refunded in full.

How many guests may we host?

If you choose package 1, you may host up to 200 guests. If you choose package 2, you may host up to 150 guests.

Will there be other events on the property?

No, we only allow one event each weekend.

When can we begin set up?

In most cases, you and your vendors will have access to the barn beginning 48 hours prior to your event and for 48 hours after. Food and all perishable items must be removed immediately after your event.

Are there restrooms available?

Restroom facilities are included your cost and will vary depending on your reception location.

May we host our rehearsal/rehearsal dinner at the venue?

Package 1 allows full use of our property for the entire weekend. Package 2 allows use of all but the barn for your wedding events.

May we host a brunch on the Sunday following our wedding?

Yes, but you will still need to adhere to our checkout and venue policies. You will also be responsible for coordinating the catering and clean up of your brunch.

Are there limitations for decorating?

No open flame or smoking is allowed in the barn. Use of candles is prohibited. Caterers may use sterno burners in designated areas. Smoking is allowed in designated areas.

Is there on-site parking for guests?

Yes, the farm allows parking at the dairy barn for all of your guests.

Do you have a dressing room for the bridal party?

Yes, the bridal party may use any room of the Inn as their dressing area. Typically, the groomsmen use the guest cabin as their dressing room.

May we choose our own vendors?

Yes, however, if the vendor you choose is not on our preferred vendors list, you must obtain approval from the venue.
